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**Agenda Item No. 1: Budget Estimates**

**a) Fund Allocation to Host State for their roles and responsibilities during Khelo India Youth Games 2020**

A letter has been received from Govt. of Assam wherein the State Government has requested for funds for the following purpose, which are already allocated to the Host State with the approval of DPAC:

***In view of the above, the approval of the Competent Authority is hereby solicited for release of Funds amounting to ₹19,87,50,000/- (Rupees Nineteen Crores Eighty-Seven Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) to the Host State for the fulfillment of their roles and responsibilities during the conduct of Khelo India Youth Games 2020.***

**b) Financial Implication due to cash awards to medalists of Khelo India Youth Games 2020**

With reference to Khelo India review meeting held on 13 Aug 2019, it is recorded in the proceeding that a suitable cash prize should be given to the winners at par with the winners of the international events. Award money as per MYAS Guidelines No. 2-3/2013-SP-IV dated 20 Jun 2017, under the "Scheme of Special Awards to Medal Winners In International Sports Events and their Coaches" is as under:



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- a) Cash Prize for senior winning Athletes as per 1.2.1 of above guidelines, calculated as per award money earmarked for Commonwealth Championship (Held once in 1 Years) (S.No 12)
- Gold @ 3.75 Lakhs.
  - Silver @ 2.5 Lakhs.
  - Bronze @ 1.25 Lakhs.
- b) As per para 1.2.2, In case of Junior Level, the amount will be one third of the amount stated in Para 1.2.1 above rounded off to nearest tens of thousands of rupees
- Gold @ 1.25 Lakhs.
  - Silver @ 83 Thousands.
  - Bronze @ 41 Thousands

*In view of the above, the approval of the Departmental Project Approval Committee is hereby solicited for the total financial implication due to suitable cash awards to be awarded to the medallists of Khelo India Youth Games 2020.*

**c) Addition of sports disciplines in Khelo India Youth Games 2020**

The sports disciplines of Cycling and Lawn Bowl have been added with the approval of the Competent Authority.

*The above is submitted for the kind perusal of the Departmental Project Approval Committee.*

**d) Procurement of Sports Kits:**

The Departmental Project Approval Committee during its meeting convened on 14.08.2019 had approved an estimated budget of INR 5.78 Crores for procurement of sports kits for Khelo India Youth Games 2020. However, with a view to significantly improve the quality of sports kits for the upcoming edition of Khelo India Youth Games 2020, the specifications have been revised to make it at par with international standards, thereby increasing the estimated budget for the procurement of sports kits to ₹ 10 Crores, approximately. However, the expenditure will be done at actuals.

*In view of the above, the approval of Departmental Project Approval Committee is hereby solicited to approve the budget of INR 10 Crores for Procurement of Sports Kits for*

***Khelo India Youth Games 2020, thereby increasing the overall estimated budget from 43.79 Crores to ₹48.11 Crores.***

**Agenda Item No. 2: Approval for Grant of financial assistance for up-gradation/creation of sports infrastructure and procurement of sports equipment in connection with holding of Khelo India Youth Games, 2020**

Khelo India Youth Games 2020 are scheduled to be held at Guwahati (Assam) from 10<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2020. The Principal Secretary, Sports and Youth Welfare Department, Assam has forwarded 33 proposals seeking financial assistance for up-gradation/creation of sports infrastructure at Guwahati under Khelo India Scheme at total estimated cost of Rs. 27.64 crore including renovation/repair of sports infrastructure at Guwahati pertaining to SAI and LNIP. Details are given in the enclosed *Annexure-2A*. In addition, requirement of funds to the tune of Rs. 12.90 crore has been projected for purchase/repair of sports equipment in respect of various sports disciplines. It has been intimated by Directorate of Sports and Youth Welfare of Assam that an amount of Rs. 5.00 crore only has been budgeted for procurement of sports equipment and a request has been made to provide additional funds to the tune of Rs. 7.90 crore (*Annexure-2B*).

2. It is proposed that financial assistance of Rs. 20.54 crore may be considered for up-gradation/creation of sports infrastructure and procurement of sports equipment in connection with holding of Khelo India Youth Games, 2020 as under:

(a) **Up-gradation/Creation of Sports Infrastructure pertaining to Sports and Youth Welfare Department, Assam:** Out of 25 proposals pertaining to Government of Assam, the following 2 proposals which are for up-gradation/creation of sports infrastructure may be considered:

(c) **Purchase of Sports Equipment** - Financial assistance of Rs. 5.63 crore may be considered to Sports and Youth Welfare Department for procurement of Shooting Equipment. After Khelo India Youth Games are over, this equipment can be used to promote Khelo India Scheme.

*In view of the above, the approval of Departmental Project Approval Committee is hereby solicited for the following:*

- Sanction of 2 projects proposal for creation/up-gradation of sports infrastructure in favor of Sports and Youth Welfare Department, Assam at total estimated cost of Rs. 13.47 crores.*
- Sanction of 8 proposals for repair/ renovation of infrastructure at Guwahati pertaining to SAI and LNIP at total estimated cost of Rs. 1.44 crore.*
- Sanction for procurement of Shooting Equipment at estimated cost of Rs. 5.63 crores.*

**Agenda Item No. 3: Budget approval of Hiring of Multi-Media Creative Agency and Social Media Management Agency for Sports Authority of India and Khelo India**

As per para 1.4.(iii) of Operational Guidelines for vertical, "Physical Fitness of School Going Children", awareness campaigns will be carried out to increase awareness amongst public about the needs and benefits of fitness. In this regard, a "Multi-Media Creative Agency" and a "Social Media Management Agency" may be hired for the same at an annual cost of ₹ 2.7 Crores.

*In view of the above, the Departmental Project Approval Committee is hereby requested to ratify the hiring of a Multi-Media Creative Agency and a Social Media Management Agency for SAI and Khelo India.*

**Agenda Item No. 4:**

**a) Engagement of Knowledge Partner and Travel Partner for Khelo India Youth Games 2020**

It was decided that a “**Knowledge Partner**” with respect to the following core areas shall be designated/ engaged for the upcoming edition of the Khelo India Youth Games 2020:

1. Games Operations:
  - a) Management of accommodation, catering, and transport
  - b) Volunteer Operations
  - c) Management of Sports Kits
  - d) Accreditation
  - e) Media and Communication
  - f) Marketing and Branding
2. Technical Conduct:
  - a) All aspects related to technical conduct of the Games
  - b) State Coordination
  - c) Communication amongst all stakeholders of Games Technical Conduct Committee
3. Games Secretariat:
  - a) Administration
  - b) Finance related matters
4. Venue Development:
  - a) Venue Overlays
  - b) Any other developmental work pertaining to the various venues/Field of Play
5. Ceremonies:
  - a) Opening and Closing Ceremony
  - b) Sports Presentations
  - c) Cultural Events during the Games

Further, the role of the Knowledge Partner during the Khelo India Youth Games 2020 is as under:

- a) Will plan and devise the key deliverables under each core area with the duly designated Core Area Heads.
- b) Prepare **SOP** for respective core area, which the Knowledge Partner will further aid the respective stakeholder in implementing during the Games.



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- c) Train Master Trainers that will be responsible to train the representatives of the Host State/Local Organizing Committee set up at the Host City;
- d) Formulate a Knowledge Manual for the conduct and execution of each core area for future reference and records.

The Knowledge Partner shall provide such services at no cost and will only be provided the right to be designated as the “*Knowledge Partner for the Khelo India Youth Games 2020*” along with boarding and lodging facilities as well as travel arrangements will be made available at each venue during the Games.

*In view of the above, the engagement of a Knowledge Partner for Khelo India Youth Games 2020 is hereby submitted for the approval of the Departmental Project Approval Committee.*

**b) Engagement of Travel Partner for Khelo India Youth Games 2020**

It was decided to engage a “**Travel Partner**” on sponsorship basis for Khelo India Youth Games 2020.

The following **roles and responsibilities** shall be undertaken by the Travel Partner for Khelo India Youth Games 2020:

- Grant of sponsorship rights as the “**Official Travel Partner**” of Khelo India Youth Games 2020;
- Design, management and execution of travel plan as per the data provided by SAI;
- Bear all requisite costs and expenses in provision of the services except for the cost of fuel and taxes as applicable. Cost of fuel and taxes (as per actuals) will be borne by SAI.
- Dedicated Help Desk and customer support services at designated airports;
- Airport Transfers of different stakeholders;
- Express check- in facilities;
- Travel Insurance as per the approved norms and guidelines;
- Complimentary meals;
- Lounge access at designated airports.

*In view of the above, the engagement of Travel Partner for Khelo India Youth Games 2020 is hereby submitted for the approval of the Departmental Project Approval Committee.*

**Agenda Item No. 5: Revision of Norms - Increase in Fees of Competition Managers (CMs) and National Technical Officials (NTOs) during Khelo India Youth Games 2020**

During First GTCC meeting held on 3 Sep 2019 in New Delhi, the representative of many NSF's raised the issue of hike in fee of ITO, NTO & CM, based on their areas of responsibilities during Game. They said that fee must commensurate the experience and certification of respective TOs. They further said that min Rs 5000/- per day be given to one

CM. On this the IOA representative intervened and said that Rs 3500/- per day per individual for CM, who is a very senior official and holds a very important role on conduct of the tournament, may be considered. They are also paid similar remunerations during National Championship. The TOs are the one who are on the fields every time their effort must be recognised, and increase is proposed accordingly. The details are as under:

The total financial implication of the above is **Rs 38,76,000/- (Rupees Thirty-Eight Lakhs Seventy-Six Thousand only)**.

***In view of the above, the approval of the Departmental Project Approval Committee is hereby solicited for the total financial implication with respect to the increase in fees of Competition Managers and National Technical Officials during Khelo India Youth Games 2020.***

**Agenda Item No. 6: Conversion of Junior Camper to Khelo India Athletes in Academies**

As per the minutes of the ACTC meetings held in various sports disciplines, early talent identification is a common factor. However, as part of the induction of proven talent it has been envisaged to convert the Junior National campers in the 20 sports identified disciplines and Sports for Differently abled sportspersons (Para Sports) in the disciplines of Para Athletics, Para Swimming, Para Badminton and Para Power lifting into academies.

As per the decision in the ACTC meetings the NSFs are to identify Zonal Academies for training the Junior campers on a continuous basis. These athletes will be treated on par with the KIAs and will be extended all financial assistance as per norms.

a) Relaxation for Age Verification Tests

As per the talent Identification procedure being followed, all the identified athletes have to undergo the Age Verification Test (AVT) by the TW3 Method. Only athletes who have cleared the AVT are finally selected to the Scheme. However, in case, the athlete is recommended by NSF, the age certified by NSF may be considered – NSF being the Nodal body for sports administration. Thus, the responsibility of taking precaution lies with the NSF.

b) Appointment of Coaches and Support Staff in Academies

The Junior Campers are to be converted into academies. For the Academies Coaching and Support staff will be hired on contract basis with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019





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to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020 as recommended by respective NSFs. The salary for the Coaches and Support Staff will be met out of the relevant vertical of Khelo India by providing funds to NSF or directly to academies/coaches as per the quantum decided.

c) Non-accredited academy:

The academies nominated by NSF shall be exempted from the current accreditation process being followed for accreditation.

d) Talent Identification process:

The current process of talent identification may not be necessary, if athletes are recommended by NSF.

*In view of the above, the approval of the Departmental Project Approval Committee is hereby solicited for the abovementioned proposals.*

**Agenda Item No. 7: Approval of sanction for the conduct of State and District Level Competition by the NSF under the Khelo India Scheme 'Promotion of Sports among Divyang Persons'.**

'Promotion of Sports among persons with Disabilities' is a vertical of Khelo India notified by MYAS on 1<sup>st</sup> Nov 2018. An ACTC Meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary Sports on 9<sup>th</sup> Aug 2019. SOB presented their requirement for National, State and District Championships.

The National Federations were advised to submit their proposal for organizing the State Games, District Games and Community Coach Training Programme. PCI, SOB and AISCD were advised to project their requirement for the National, State and District Competitions. A meeting was held with the representatives of SOB, AISCD and PCI.

Proposals which were received from SOB, PCI and AISCD are as follows:

1. AISCD : (22 States, 03 UTs, 238 Districts) : **Rs. 4,95,14,24,000**
2. PCI: (12 States, 01 UT, 419 Districts) : **Rs. 15,83,09,550**
3. SOB : (28 States, 05 UTS, 722 Districts) : **Rs. 07,01,28,000**

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**TOTAL = Rs. 5,17,98,61,550/-**

**(Rupees Five Hundred Seventeen Crore Ninety Eight Lakh Sixty One Thousand Five Hundred and Fifty Only)**

The proposals were re-examined multiple times while the NSFs were encouraged to be realistic in their proposals. The final outcome of deliberations which is proposed below has been drawn in consultation with SOB and AISCD only since PCI has been derecognized by MYAS. The activities proposed below along with financials cover the entire nation with special emphasis on North Eastern States and UTs with adequate opportunity for athletes who are covered under the category of **Divyang**.

The proposal has been drafted in a manner that it enables conduct of the competitions in joint collaboration between NSF creating an environment of sports festival. This will ensure dissemination of information on the scheme of Khelo India throughout the nation and also be a catalyst in encouraging youth for participating in sports which shall help them improve the quality of their lives.

**Agenda Item No. 8: Grant of sponsorship for conducting All India Festival of Folk Martial Arts and Indigenous Games 'Shourya Parva- 2019' at New Delhi and Northern States under the Khelo India Scheme proposed by Karnataka Sahasa Kala Academy.**

The proposal received from Karnataka Sahasa Kala Academy is for organizing an All India Festival of Folk Martial Arts and Indigenous Games 'Shourya Parva-2019' with the objective of facilitating Interactive sessions and lectures amongst the 300-500 Artists scholars,

experts from the field of folk, Folk Martial Arts troupes, Theatre & Indigenous Art from all over India. Folk martial artists from the States will also be participating in the programme and senior Folk Experts will be special invitees to the programme. The programme will be conducted in the five days festival in Chandigarh, Punjab and New Delhi in different places. The proposal states that the following activities shall take place during the festival.

- Performance of Indigenous Martial Arts.
- Performance and Competition of Traditional Games.
- Performance of Traditional Stunt Shows.
- Performance & Competitions of Strongest Man in the country.
- Any other performance and competition related to traditional indigenous martial arts.

The estimated expenditure in the proposal amounts to Rs. 1,08,50,000/- (Rupees One Crore Eighty Lakh Fifty Thousand only)

Promotion of Indigenous and Rural/Tribal Sports is a vertical of Khelo India Scheme which aims to promote the local forms of sports which is essentially a diminishing form due to urbanization and non-recognition of traditional sports.

There are numerable organizations working at the State and National level who are promoting indigenous art forms which also includes sports, however, sanctioning of funds for such festivals could be encouraged in a limited way; such as making the venue available free for hosting the event, prize money for winners of sports events etc. This way we would encourage promotion of indigenous rural and tribal sports and at the same time we would not be digressing from the aims and objectives of our scheme. The sports disciplines such as mud Wrestling, Judo, Boxing and Gymnastics will be played.

As the scheme of Khelo India is limited to promoting indigenous sport, the expenditure proposed at Sl. No. 08 of the approximate budget states Rs. 04 lakh for meeting the expenditure on inaugural and closing ceremony, mementos, certificates, guest expenses etc, we may consider granting a limited sponsorship for sports purpose only (*Annexure-8A*).

***In view of the above, the approval of the Departmental Project Approval Committee is hereby requested for release of grant amounting to Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Only) for the conduct of All India Festival of Folk Martial Arts and Indigenous Games 'Shourya Parva-2019'***


**Agenda Item No. II: Approval of DPAC for norms for expenditure parameters for training of Athletes under SAI National Centre of Excellence**


