

MINUTES OF THE DEPARTMENTAL PROJECT APPROVAL COMMITTEE
HELD ON 17TH FEBRUARY, 2020 AT 14:30 HRS UNDER THE
CHAIRMANSHIP OF SECRETARY (SPORTS) MYAS

Agenda Item No. 1: Norms for accommodation and catering (AC) in KIIT University during Khelo India University Games 2020 Odisha

The Committee discussed the norms to be prescribed for providing funding to KIIT University with respect to accommodation. The Committee noted that MYAS provides a grant of Rs. 1200/- per day per camper for holding of National Camps to NSF's for providing lodging facilities to the national campers in SAI premises. Further, it is also to be noted that SAI provides Rs. 300/- per day per head to its field units (existing residential facilities) for meeting expenditure towards maintenance and operation of hostel complex in various regional centres, while the remaining amount of Rs. 900/- is used for operation and maintenance, and up-gradation of facilities for National coaching campers of SAI.

The Committee observed that though most of the rooms in KIIT University hostels will be triple occupancy, the expenditure may be restricted to the rates of double occupancy, i.e. Rs. 600/room/day.

So far as catering is concerned, the Committee took note that the internal committee of OTDC had recommended the amount Rs.975/- per athlete to KIIT University, which was arrived by benchmarking the tender rates of KIYG 2020 for catering of volunteers and officials and thus included the profit component of the respective vendor/caterer. The menu provided by Govt. of Odisha was compared with the diet plan of senior camper by nutritionists and Senior Scientific Officer of SAI, and it was observed that the diet plan for senior campers is comparable with the diet plan proposed by Govt. of Odisha, and is even slightly better. Further considering that during competitions, the requirement would be little more elaborate in comparison to normal training days due to presence of different stakeholders, the Committee approved the rate of Rs. 700/- per person per day plus applicable taxes for the catering provided by KIIT University.

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So far as transportation is concerned, the Committee decided that the fuel charges (petrol, diesel, CNG, etc.) shall be paid to KIIT University on actual basis.

Agenda Item No. 2 and 3: Budget for the conduct of Khelo India University Games 2020 and Publicity for Khelo India University Games 2020

The Committee noted that the Khelo India University Games 2020 is scheduled to start within a week, and thus decided that the budget estimates may be presented based on actuals during the Games.

Accordingly, the agenda item was deferred with the above observations.

Agenda No. 4: On-ground sponsorship for Khelo India University Games Odisha 2020

The Committee noted and approved the engagement of on-ground sponsors for Khelo India University Games 2020. Further, the Committee also confirmed the two PSUs, Indian Oil Corporation Limited as the Presenting Sponsor, and Gas Authority of India Limited as the Co-Presenting Sponsor during Khelo India University Games Odisha 2020 on account of their proposals. The Committee further authorized DG (SAI) to take all decisions regarding the branding opportunities, elements, placement of logos, etc. pertaining to the sponsors of Khelo India University Games 2020.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
