2	Action Taken report on the 31st meeting of DPAC held on 21.12.2021	Noted. A portal for monitoring of Khelo India Scheme may be developed by MDSD.
3	Approval of Funds for Digital, Branding and Communication Agency	Approved in principle. Details of budget head will be conveyed by MYAS.
4	Approval of Funds for Geo tagging of Playfields and Marketing Campaign	Approved with the condition that fund for marketing campaign is restricted to Rs. One crore. The fund for PMU was approved only for a year.
5	Approval of Funds for Development of content for digital coaching modules of e- Khel Pathshala	Approved in principle. Expenditure is to be met from appropriate budget head to be decided by MYAS. However, the extra expenditure incurred within overall budget for the pilot project in the Boxing discipline was approved.
6	Approval of budgetary provision of 270 Lakhs for Opening of Khelo India Centres in the States of Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh & UT of Delhi	Approved. However, out of 07 KICs proposal of Delhi at Delhi, International Kair Sports Complex, South West (for athletics) and Ludlow Castle Sports Complex (for Yoga) have been deferred.



7	De-notification of four Schools.	Deferred. SAI shall conduct a detailed discussion with concerned authorities for making these operational.
8	Budget provision of Rs. 77,25,000/- for the engagement of Human Resource in Khelo India by extending the approval given in previous DPAC.	Approved for this financial year. A detailed review of manpower in the light of approved cadre restructuring of SAI along may be conducted taking into account the requirement of Khelo India.
9	Reimbursement of Khelo India academies for the lockdown period for Quarter 3 and Quarter 4 of Financial Year 2020-21.	Approved
10	Grant of Out of Pocket Allowances (OPA) to the Khelo India Athletes of Indigenous Games (04) for Q2, Q3 and Q4 of F.Y.2021-22.	Approved subject to the following: 1) No more OPA to be given to existing athletes. 2) List of eligible candidates shall be prepared by forming Khelo India Talent Development Committees exactly as being done under Khelo India Talent Development Vertical. The fresh selection should be done on the basis of current performance. OPA/Scholarship will be given from prospective effect. Regular weeding out may be conducted as per usual practice. 3) Silambam, an indigenous game of Tamil Nadu is also added to the existing indigenous games covered under PRITG vertical of Khelo India. 4) The scholarship/OPA will be given to max 350 athletes.
